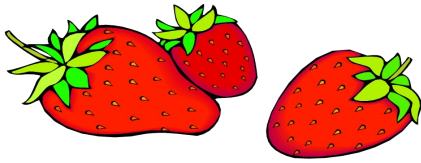

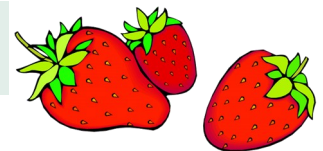
This year we shall once again, be holding the cake decorating competition for all school children. Each year group will be judged separately and prizes will be awarded accordingly.

Entry to this competition remains at 50p. The attached slip needs to be completed and returned to school by Wednesday 17th in order for you to receive your child's cake competition tray.

Because we know that time is precious and in short supply, there is a possibility this year for you to purchase the cakes and the tray ready for decoration. Simply complete the attached slip, and your cakes will be returned home on Thursday evening in the competition tray ready to be decorated on Thursday night and returned ready for the competition on Friday. (cost is £1—includes competition entry)

In order for us to organise a rota can you please indicate on the attached slip if your child is available to assist with this and what time they would be available, and return this to the school office by Wednesday am.

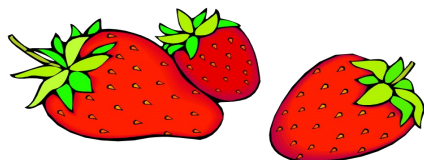

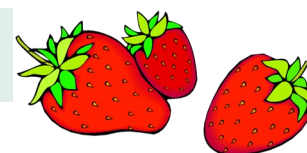
