

Fundraising

The majority of our funds are raised through the events that we run. We hold an annual Strawberry Fair and Christmas Craft & Gift Fair as well other smaller events throughout the year as suggested by the Committee. There is always something going on and we always try and respond to both children's and parent's requests.

We raise money in other ways too. Donations from parents are extremely important. You can donate time, money, items for sale, raffle prizes and auction lots or offers of services and skills. Our Monthly Draw is also a way that you can donate a small amount but that makes a big difference annually.

Decisions on how to spend the money we raise are agreed at FLSA Committee meetings.

Usually, the school's Head teacher, Andrea Kenny, has a 'wish list' of items that school would like us to consider funding but due to large budget cuts, for the past two years we have supported school's swimming programme for all Year 2, 3 and 4 pupils. Swimming support will continue for 2012/13 but is reviewed annually.

Remaining FLSA funds are spent on the 'extras' that are not provided by the school's budget, thus making our children's learning experiences so much more fulfilling and exciting.
