7. Any other comments	<p><i>I think swimming is a really important part of the curriculum and should be maintained if possible. It brings balance to an academic week!</i></p> <p><i>Swimming is a very important lesson and is vital for life!</i></p> <p><i>Think it's good for them to go with school because it gives them independence to change. Also I feel that they perform better without a parent present.</i></p>	

It is very clear that parents place a huge value on the school's swimming lessons and strongly affirm that they wish it to retain within the curriculum. This is reinforced by 25% of parents responding offering to pay a nominal fee.
