### Summary of Sports Premium Spending 2015-16

#### In our school we are using this funding in the following ways:-

- Increase the range of different competitive sports our children participate in
- To buy in a specialist coach to lead PE lessons and support, develop and up-skill the new teaching staff through Burton Albion Community Trust
- To increase the diversity and range of additional clubs which will strengthen and embed the skills taught in the curriculum for the children in KS1
- To embed the lunchtime games and sports offered including training our Young Leaders and the implementation of the Change for Life Programme
- To provide the transportation to attend sporting competitions and festivals
- To provide weekly swimming lessons for all pupils in Y2, Y3 Y4

### Impact of Sports Premium Spending 2015 -16

- Sainsburys School Game Gold Award achieved (Silver level in 2014- 15, and Bronze level was awarded in 2013 -14)
- Increased participation in inter-school competitions – 100% of KS2 pupils continued to participate in a range of tournaments and in addition, 71% of children in Y2 took part in competition
- Specialist coaching has bought in high quality and more varied PE curriculum
- PLT has attended termly network meetings with all schools and CPD opportunities offered by Castele Consultancy
- Maintenance of 2 hours of timetabled physical activity per week with additional activities offered after school and at lunchtime
- Sports Council has been introduced who organise and report on sporting events.
- All Y4 pupils leave this school as competent swimmers
